

A new site on the CDC Internet provides quick and easy access to Comprehensive Cancer Control (CCC) plans. To access it, go to: <a href="http://www.cdc.gov/cancer/ncccp/ccc\_plans.htm">http://www.cdc.gov/cancer/ncccp/ccc\_plans.htm</a>.

Currently, all 50 states, the District of Columbia, seven tribes and tribal organizations, and seven territories and U.S. Pacific Island jurisdictions, have produced 65 plans. In addition to these plans, the Cancer Council of the Pacific Islands (CCPI) developed a Pacific Regional Plan.

The new site features a U.S. map like the one shown below, as well as a list of plans and the PDFs.



To access a PDF of a specific CCC plan, either:

- Click the link (state, U.S. territory, or tribe/tribal organization) provided in the map, or
- Review the lists of plans (state, U.S. territory, or tribe/tribal organization) and click on the hyperlink to access the PDF of a specific CCC plan

Formerly, CCC plans were available on the National Cancer Institute's Cancer Control P.L.A.N.E.T. portal. In time, CCC plans will be transitioned off this portal and a link will be provided to allow users quick access to the CDC site.
