LET'S CELEBRATE OUR RESILIENCE BY GETTING VACCINATED!



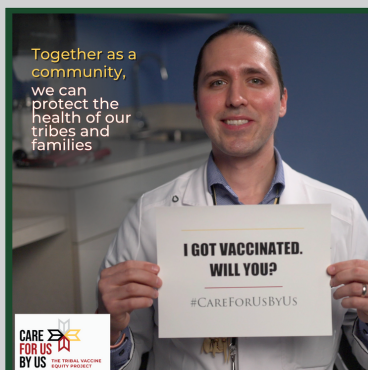
